ALL-SEASON ROAD CONSTRUCTION UNDERWAY

*Slow Down when Approaching
Workers and Equipment*



The East Side Road Authority (ESRA) is reminding all drivers who travel on winter roads on the east side of Lake Winnipeg that construction has begun on the all-season road network. Drivers can expect to encounter construction workers and equipment at any and all times anywhere in the vicinity of the winter road.

Along PR 304 to Bloodvein First Nation (KM 0 to KM 85), construction can be expected:

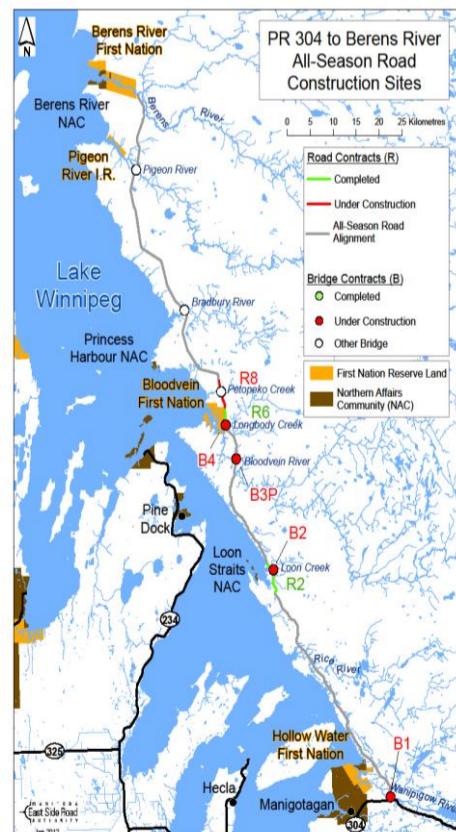
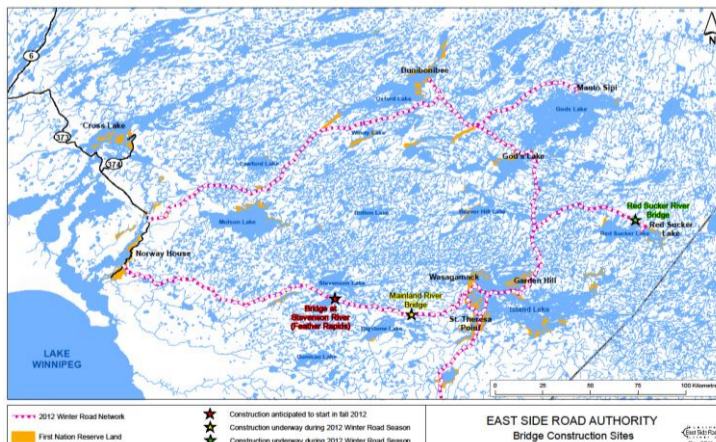
- Wanipigow River Bridge from PR 304 to KM 1
- Loon Creek from KM 53 to 54
- Bloodvein River from KM 77 to 78
- Longbody Creek from KM 84 to Km 85
- Brush Clearing from KM 1 to KM 67

North of Bloodvein (KM 0), construction sites include:

- North of Longbody Creek from KM 3 to KM 8
- Brush Clearing from KM 3 to KM 56

Farther north, drivers can expect construction workers and equipment at:

- Mainland River Bridge
- Red Sucker River Bridge



All drivers are advised to slow down, follow all signs, and use caution when approaching construction workers and equipment.
