

THE EAST SIDE ROAD AUTHORITY

To improve transportation for residents on the east side of Lake Winnipeg, the East Side Road Authority (ESRA) is constructing a 160 kilometer all-season road from PR 304 to Berens River First Nation. In addition, ESRA is also examining transportation improvements for the remainder of the region. As the project proceeds, ESRA requires the following technical staff:

Road & Structures Engineers – A Professional Engineer (APEGM) with experience in the field of Structural Engineering related to northern roads and/or bridge construction. Experience with Primavera or other contract management software would be an asset. Travel to remote locations in Manitoba will be requirement of this position.

Construction Field Inspectors – A Certified Engineering Technologist or Technician with experience in contract administration/construction inspection related to heavy civil constructions. Experience with Primavera or other contract management software would be an asset. Field inspection in remote areas of Manitoba for four to eight consecutive days at a time is a requirement of this position.

Environmental Specialist/Inspectors – A graduate of a recognized environmental science program with field experience. A good knowledge of environmental protection principles and the ability to prepare monitoring and data reports. Knowledge/experience in terrestrial biology, heavy construction and workplace safety and health would be an asset. Field inspection and environmental monitoring in remote areas of Manitoba for four to eight consecutive days at a time is requirement of this position.

GIS Analyst – A graduate of a recognized GIS technology or university degree program having experience in the creation and manipulation of various documents using GIS technology for both technical (engineering and construction) and communications use. The applicant must be experienced in the use of ESRI, AutoCad, MS Excel and Access and remote sensing software and management of data files and software.

Safety Officers – A Construction Safety Officer (CSO) or a graduate of a recognized safety and health program who is fully knowledgeable of all elements related to the construction industry's Certificate of Recognition (COR) safety program requirements and has several years experience in delivering and managing a comprehensive safety and health program related to heavy civil construction works (bridges, roadwork, concrete structures, etc.). Field inspection in remote areas of Manitoba for four to eight consecutive days at a time is requirement of this position.

The successful applicants will:

- work closely with Aboriginal communities
- require problem solving skills in dealing with contractors and consultants
- be proficient in relevant computer application
- demonstrate good oral and written communication skills
- be highly organized and be able work both independently and in a team environment
